

Mission Statement

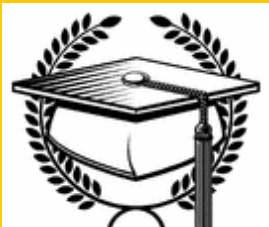

What is the Carlisle Alumni Association?

The Carlisle Alumni Association began in 1958. Every person graduating from the Carlisle Community School District automatically becomes an alumnus and is a member of the association for one year, after which dues are required to receive the annual newsletter.

How is a Memorial Established?

To establish a Carlisle Alumni Memorial, the funeral director may include in the obituary notice "Donations may be made to "Your Loved One's' Fund", Carlisle Alumni Association, P.O.Box 3, Carlisle, IA 50047. This will quickly notify family and friends of your wishes. When ready, the family may contact the association to determine the type of memorial desired.

Memorial Types

1. A scholarship named after your loved one.
2. Or, a gift to the endowment fund.

Memorial Scholarships

If the total monies donated in memory of a loved one amount to \$500 or more, a one-time scholarship award "In memory of your loved one" will be awarded at the following graduation. A friend or family member is encouraged to present the scholarship at the banquet.

Memorial Gifts for the General Endowment Fund

If the total monies donated in memory of a loved one amount to \$500 or less, monies contributed will be placed in the endowment fund to be combined with other donations. Donors will be listed in the banquet program and the annual newsletter. Families will be notified of each thoughtful memorial gift at the time of receipt.

How Does the General Endowment Fund Work?

The endowment program works on a simple concept. Donations and gifts are invested in an interest-bearing instrument. Each year the interest generated by the investment is awarded as a scholarship. The original amount remains in the interest-bearing instrument to generate more interest, which in turn will be awarded the next year. These scholarships are simply named the Alumni Scholarships and do not include a person's name.
