PENNIES FOR PLAY

The Carlisle Schools would like to thank all those in the community who participated in or co-hosted the Hartford Upper Elementary Pennies for Play campaign this past month. The Hartford Elementary campaign of Pennies for Play completed last week with an additional \$542.31 raised. Mrs. Folsom's class was the big winner this week, raising a total of \$353.80 in their class. The grand total raised during the month of February through the school was \$1,519.35. In addition, funds are being tallied this week from the community jars to obtain a total for the Pennies for Play campaign. As announced several weeks ago, the Warren County Iowa Chapter of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans pledged support for the Pennies for Play. The donations will be supplemented by the Warren County Iowa chapter of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans; they will supplement \$1 for every \$2 donated up to a maximum supplement of \$1,500. Final campaign results will be available later this week.

CARLISLE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVES PRAIRIE MEADOWS GRANT

The Carlisle Community School District and the Hartford Playground Committee are pleased to announce the receipt of a \$10,000 grant from Prairie Meadows Racetrack and Casino as part of their 2009 Community Betterment Grant Program. The grant money will enable the school district to purchase new playground equipment for Hartford Upper Elementary School. The Playground Renovation Committee's goal is to raise a minimum of \$50,000 through grants and fundraising efforts. To date, the committee has raised a total of \$48,165. All funds raised by the committee will help defray the school district's costs associated with the renovation of the Hartford playground. The Carlisle Community School District, in partnership with students, families and our community, firmly believes that children deserve a safe, caring environment where their needs are met; learn respect for themselves and others; need developmentally appropriate opportunities to learn and explore; and are encouraged to strive for excellence in every endeavor. SPRING BOOT CAMP**
