## **CARLISLE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS – HARTFORD PLAYGROUND COMMITTEE RECEIVES GRANT**

Carlisle Community Schools and the Hartford Playground Committee are pleased to announce the receipt of a \$5,000 grant from the Warren County Philanthropic Partnership. The grant money will assist the school district in purchasing new playground equipment for Hartford Upper Elementary School. The Playground Renovation Committee's original goal was to raise a minimum of \$50,000 through grants and fundraising efforts. To date, the committee has raised a total of **\$56,887.37**. All funds raised by the committee will help defray the school district's costs associated with the renovation of the Hartford playground.

The Warren County Philanthropic Partnership was organized to promote and enhance community-based philanthropy in Warren County. They recently received a state award to facilitate endowment building and grant making. The contribution to the foundation was made possible by the Iowa General Assembly. In 2004, the Iowa legislature passed several bills to encourage foundation building and community-based philanthropy. Among these measures was House File 2032 which provided that non-gambling counties who initiated a county-wide community foundation would be eligible to receive one-half of one percent of the state's gross gambling tax receipts. Twenty six grant applications were received and twenty two organizations across Warren County shared in the funding allocations.

Carlisle Community Schools, in partnership with students, families and our community, firmly believes that children deserve a safe, caring environment where their needs are met; learn respect for themselves and others; need developmentally appropriate opportunities to learn and explore; and are encouraged to strive for excellence in every endeavor. Carlisle Community Schools and the Hartford Playground Renovation Committee are very appreciative of the Warren County Philanthropic Partnership grant.
