CARLISLE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS – HARTFORD PLAYGROUND COMMITTEE RECEIVES GRANT

Carlisle Community Schools and the Hartford Playground Committee are pleased to announce the receipt of a \$500 grant from the Greater Carlisle Community Foundation. The grant money will assist the school district in purchasing new playground equipment for Hartford Upper Elementary School. The Playground Renovation Committee's original goal was to raise a minimum of \$50,000 through grants and fundraising efforts. To date, the committee has raised a total of **\$56,887.37**. All funds raised by the committee will help defray the school district's costs associated with the renovation of the Hartford playground.

The Greater Carlisle Community Foundation was formed in 2005 to coordinate and provide philanthropic support for community betterment projects in the greater Carlisle area, including the communities of Palmyra, Easter Lake, Avon, Carlisle and Hartford. The mission of the Greater Carlisle Community Foundation is to promote philanthropy throughout these P.E.A.C.H. communities. The Foundation is made up of community-minded individuals who have the ability to assess community needs, implement asset development, evaluate area grant applications, and encourage partnerships and initiate activities to enhance the quality of life.
